AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FLAG POLICY OF THE TOWN OF BARRINGTON

CHAPTER 104 – FLAG POLICY



Sec. 104-2. Declaration of Policy.

It is the standing practice of the Town to raise the official Flag of the United States of America on the Town Hall flagpole and other flagpoles on municipal property. It is also the standing practice of the Town to raise the “Prisoner of War/Missing in Action” (“POW/MIA”) flag beneath the United States flag on the Town Hall flagpole. It is the standing practice of the Town to raise, beneath the POW/MIA flag on the Town Hall flagpole, a Pride Flag during the month of June to celebrate LGBT Pride Month, a flag commemorating the Armenian Genocide on Armenian Genocide Remembrance Day on the appropriate day in April, an Autism Awareness Flag on all other days during the month of April to recognize Autism Awareness Month, and The Pan-African Flag or other appropriate flag to celebrate Black History Month during the month of February. The method for establishing or ceasing additional flag-raising shall be set forth in this ordinance.
