

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-15

**AN AMENDMENT TO CHAPTERS 1, 19, 63, 124, AND 131 OF THE
ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF BARRINGTON**

Chapter 1

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article I

ADOPTION OF CODE

* * *

§ 1-13 Tampering with Code; penalties.

Any person who, without authorization from the Town Clerk, changes or amends, by additions or deletions, any part or portion of the Code of the Town of Barrington, or who alters or tampers with such Code in any manner whatsoever which will cause the legislation of the town to be misrepresented thereby, or who violates any other provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be guilty of a violation, punishable by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.) ~~or by imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days.~~

Chapter 19

MUNICIPAL COURT

* * *

§ 19-2 Jurisdiction.

To otherwise compel compliance with all provisions of said ordinances and statutes.

D. With respect to violations of all municipal ordinances, the Town Council hereby confers upon said Municipal Court, in furtherance of the aforementioned jurisdiction, the power to fine ~~and imprison~~ violators in accordance with applicable provisions of the Town Code and enabling legislation.

E. With respect to violations of municipal ordinances addressing both moving and nonmoving traffic violations, the Town Council hereby confers upon said Municipal Court, in furtherance of the aforementioned jurisdiction, the power to fine ~~and imprison~~ violators in accordance with §§ **179-6** through **179-16**.

§ 19-3 Fines; penalties; ~~imprisonment.~~

Said Municipal Court may ~~impose a sentence not to exceed 30 days in jail and~~ impose a fine not in excess of \$500 for each offense, ~~or both~~, and shall be empowered to punish persons for contempt by fine ~~or punishment~~. Provided, however, where jurisdiction is conferred upon the Municipal Court pursuant to R.I.G.L. § 8-18-3(b)(3), all penalties assessed shall be consistent with the violation schedule contained in Appendix Chapter ~~A225~~, § ~~A225-1~~, of this Code, and R.I.G.L. Title 31, Chapter 41.1.

Chapter 63

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Article I

POSSESSION AND CONSUMPTION

* * *

§ 63-2 Violations and penalties.

Pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws, any person who violates the provisions of this Article shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the amount of \$20 ~~or imprisonment not exceeding 10 days in some jail or house of correction for any one offense, to be prosecuted by the same officer appointed for that purpose.~~

Chapter 124

LICENCES AND PERMITS

Article I

PEDDLING, SOLICITING AND TRANSIENT MERCHANTS

§ 124-12 Violations and penalties.

Any person who violates the provisions of this article or who files, or causes to be filed, an application for a permit under this article containing false or fraudulent statements or who utilizes or employs fraudulent means in connection with any solicitation or sale shall be fined not more than \$500 ~~and/or serve up to 30 days in prison.~~

Article II

SECONDHAND DEALERS

* * *

§ 124-22 Violations and penalties.

Any person carrying on any business set forth in § 124-13 of this Article without a license shall be fined not exceeding \$500 ~~or imprisoned not exceeding six months for any one offense.~~

Article III

SHOWS, EXHIBITIONS AND ENTERTAINMENT

§ 124-35 Enforcement; violations and penalties.

C. Any person violating any sections of this Article shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$500 ~~or by imprisonment of not more than 30 days, or both.~~ The continuation of a violation of any provision of this Article shall constitute, for each day the violation is continued, a separate and distinct violation hereunder.

Chapter 131

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

* * *

§ 131-3 Applicability; violations and penalties.

* * *

B. Whoever violates the provisions herein may be fined \$100 for the first offense, up to \$250 for a second offense, and up to \$500 for a third offense. Additionally, whoever violates the provisions herein may be ordered to perform up to 30 50 hours of community service, or make restitution, ~~or be imprisoned for not more than 30 days.~~
