You don't need to have a student in the senior class to recognize how AfterProm benefits our community. Donations have decreased in recent years, and we need your help.

From 1999 to 2007, Barrington experienced too many teen deaths involving substance use. While none of these happened on prom night in our community, research shows that teenage car crash deaths peak from May to August.

- ▶ The **AfterProm** was started in 2002 as a senior project to provide a safe, substance-free, all-night-celebration after the BHS senior prom. It is a free event attended by the majority of the class.
- ▶ **AfterProm** is from 11:30 pm to 6 am at BHS. The gyms and foyers are completely transformed by a theme with a food court, casino, games (obstacle course, laser tag, mechanical bull, human twister, sumo wrestling). Also there are tattoo artists, palm readers, a hypnotist, and a DJ. The event ends with over 100 prizes given away with an additional 10-15 grand prizes. To win a prize, the student must remain until the end.
- ▶ The event is completely paid for by donations from parents, community members, businesses and faculty.
