Practice safety on the roads and in the water

- Car crash risk increases exponentially with the addition of each younger passenger in a car driven by a 16- or 17-year-old
- About 1 in 5 people who die from drowning are children age 14 and younger. Among adolescents and adults alcohol is involved in up to 70% of deaths associated with water recreation
- Helmets work! Adults and children should wear helmets for any sport involving wheels
