

**ORDINANCE 2015-1**

**AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT TO  
CHAPTER 41 POLICE DEPARTMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS  
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF BARRINGTON**

The Town Council of the Town of Barrington hereby ordains:

**ARTICLE II**

**Courtesy and Conduct**

\* \* \*

**§41-7. Obedience to superior officers.**

- A. Members shall promptly obey all lawful orders given to them by a superior officer. If an order is not understood, it is the responsibility of the member to obtain clarification from the superior officer. Members who are given orders which appear unlawful or to be in conflict with previously issued orders, rules, or regulations shall respectfully inform the superior officer who issued the conflicting order. The responsibility for the conflict will then be assumed by the superior officer. If the superior officer does not alter or retract the conflicting order, the member shall promptly obey the order.

After the order is followed, if the members still believes it to be unlawful or in conflict with previously issued orders, the member may report the matter to a high ranking officer up to the Chief of Police if necessary.

- B. All general or special orders, memorandums, notices or other orders printed upon authorized Department forms, that have been approved by the Chief of Police or authorized individual, shall have the force and effect of a Department regulation.
