



EXECUTIVE ORDER 2021-8

WHEREAS the Town of Barrington Town Council declared a state of emergency through an emergency ordinance enacted on March 14, 2020, to deal with the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS the Town Council delegated emergency authority to the Town Manager to take measures he deems necessary in order to protect public health and safety in response to the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the emergency power delegated, and state of emergency declared by the Town Council, has been continued in effect inclusive of the current date;

1. This Executive Order supersedes Executive Order 2021-7.
2. **Effective immediately, face mask or cloth face shield are required in all municipal buildings (Town Hall, Peck Center / Library, DPW, Public Safety and Schools), except for children under two (2) years of age and persons with physical or developmental disabilities that prevent wearing of face coverings. Masks and face coverings must be worn over the nose and the mouth.**
3. While not mandated, local businesses are encouraged to implement masking requirements as they deem appropriate.
4. This executive order shall remain in effect until terminated or superseded by a subsequent order.
