Rhode Island's percent positivity rate, as it relates to COVID-19, is down from last week, now 2.3% (2.5% last week).

# **COVID-19 Vaccine Information**

**Additional Vaccine Appointments:** Today (4/23) at 5 p.m., roughly 12,000 additional vaccine appointments will be posted on <a href="https://www.vaccinateRI.org">www.vaccinateRI.org</a>.

**Current Eligibility:** All Rhode Islanders ages 16 and older, and those that work in R.I. are eligible.

**Transportation:** R.I. Public Transit Authority is offering free fares to those going to and from vaccination appointments. People with vaccine appointments can <u>email</u> or call 401-781-9400.

**Vaccines for Veterans:** The Providence Veterans Medical Center is hosting a drive through vaccination clinic on May 1st from 9am-3pm at the Medical Center on Chalkstone Ave., Providence. Sign up <a href="here">here</a>. For more information click here or call 401-273-7100 ext. 16226.
