

BARRINGTON TOWN MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE

Dear Barrington Residents, Businesses, and Community Partners,

I hope you are well. Rhode Island's cases of COVID-19 continue to average between 300-400 per day (2.4% weekly positivity rate). With highly contagious variants of the virus still present, it is important to wear high-quality masks, wash your hands, limit large gatherings, and keep your distance. Statewide 648,334 doses have been administered and 275,464 people have been fully vaccinated.

COVID-19 Vaccine

Additional Vaccine Appointments: Today (4/9) at 5 p.m., roughly 20,000 vaccine appointments will be posted on www.vaccinateRI.org.

Current Eligibility: People age 50 and older who live, work, or go to school in Rhode Island.

Expanded Eligibility:

- Monday, April 12th residents ages 40 and older can register.
- Monday, April 12th, those 16 and older who live and work in the hard-hit zip codes of 02893, 02906, 02910, 02920, 02911, 02914, and 02919 will be eligible to register.
- Starting April 19th, all Rhode Islanders ages 16 and older will be eligible.

Homebound Vaccinations: Those that are homebound and filled out the state's survey may receive calls from one of these three vendors: MedTech, Alert Ambulance, and PACERI, in order to schedule at date/time to receive their vaccination at the address they provided. If you are homebound and have not requested a vaccine, please do so through this survey: http://bit.ly/homeboundvax.

New Clinics: Barrington was proud to partner with our neighboring communities this week to open a new clinic in East Providence. Additional regional clinics were opened in Johnston and Westerly. Appointments will be made available through the state's vaccine <u>sign-up portal</u>.

Pre-Register: Rhode Islanders can now preregister for the vaccine on <u>portal.ri.gov</u> or by calling 844-930-1779.

Options for eligible Rhode Islanders to be vaccinated:

- 1. **State Sites:** Register for a vaccine <u>here</u> or call 844-930-1779.
- 2. **Regional Sites:** Located in East Providence, Johnston and Westerly. Appointments are required. Visit https://www.vaccinateri.org/.
- 3. Pharmacies: CVS, Walgreens, Walmart, Stop and Shop.
